

Strategic Tutoring, Assessing Phase

Questions the Tutor Asks the Student

1. Define/clarify the task.
 - What is it you are supposed to do?
 - When is it due?
 - What materials do you need to complete it?
2. Identify student's way of completing the task.
 - How do you usually do this problem?
 - How did your teacher tell you to do this homework?
3. Obtain student's commitment to learn a more efficient strategy for completing task.
 - How well did your way of solving these types of problems work for you?
 - Do you want to know a different way of trying to solve these types of problems?

Then the tutor identifies what he or she knows about completing the task.
 Tutor asks self: "Do I know a strategy to complete this task?"

Assessing Phase Checklist

The following checklist is a tool to serve as a reminder of what needs to be accomplished during the assessing phase.

- _____ 1. Ask the student about the assignment.
 - a. What is it?
 - b. When is it due?
 - c. What materials are needed to complete it?
- _____ 2. Determine the student's current strategy.
- _____ 3. Review previous performance on similar assignments.
- _____ 4. Ask the student how the teacher suggested he or she study?
- _____ 5. Ask the student if the current strategy works.
- _____ 6. Provide reasons for learning a new strategy.
- _____ 7. Gain the student's commitment.
- _____ 8. Make a commitment to the student.
